A EU document reveals concerns about the credibility and human rights in Tunisia

A leaked internal report from the EU's diplomatic service (EEAS) expresses fears that the credibility of the European Union is at risk as it attempts to balance growing concerns about repression of dissent in Tunisia while preserving a controversial migration agreement with the North African country.

The report, obtained by the Guardian, describes "a clear deterioration of the political climate and a civic space at risk of reduction" under Tunisian President Kais Saied, who suspended parliament and concentrated power in his hands since the start of his mandate in 2024.

EU officials hope Saied will continue in power after presidential elections in October. The campaign for the elections was marked by the arrest of opponents and the persecution of dissidents under charges of spreading false information.

The document also feeds concerns about the EU-Tunisia migration pact of 2024, aiming to prevent people from reaching Europe from the country, a move that has already led to accusations of financing dictators.

The five-page report details the arrest of opposition politicians, journalists, lawyers, and business owners ahead of the presidential elections next month. It also mentions the arrest of people working for NGOs that help immigrants, "most of whom are partners in the implementation of programs funded by the EU", according to the document.

Since the report was written, more people have been detained, including human rights activist and journalist Sihem Bensedrine, a former president of the Truth and Dignity Commission, established after the Arab Spring to investigate decades of human rights abuses. She was arrested under a preventive detention regime on August 1st, following an investigation widely considered to be based on false accusations.

Before her arrest, Bensedrine denounced political repression and the "toxic climate" in Tunisia, following racist speeches by Saied against immigrants from sub-Saharan Africa.

The report notes that "public indignation and scrutiny" over violence, expulsions, and other mistreatment of immigrants and asylum seekers "in which authorities are generally involved" raises "critical questions about EU support for border management".

The report was commissioned by Borrell and sent to 27 EU foreign ministers.

The Guardian shared a copy with Hussein Baoumi, of Amnesty International, who said the analysis of the report reflects a very serious situation. "There is no way to hide this reality: the situation in Tunisia in terms of human rights and democratic backsliding is very worrying."

In the final part of the report, however, it "seems to have been written by someone completely different" who did not read the previous pages, according to Baoumi. "He is saying that the EU should continue to get more involved with Tunisian authorities, continue to expand cooperation, a partnership, even though it is clearly aware that this would be a violation of EU commitments to promote human rights, international law, and the rule of law."
