A Texas hold 'em match in progress. Hold 'em is a popular form of poker in the USA.

Poker is a game which people play with a normal set (or deck) of 52 cards. Poker is a gambling game which involves some luck, but also some skill. In poker, players make bets against each other depending on the value of their poker hand. Bets are usually made with plastic or ceramic discs called chips. Bets may also be made with coins or cash, but chips are more often used because they are easier to handle and count. At the end of the game, players may swap their chips for money. If the players are not playing for real money, the chips are counted at the end of the game to determine the order of winners.

There are many different kinds of poker. In draw poker, each player is dealt five cards. A player can decide to throw away a number of these cards and then take (draw) new cards to replace them.

In stud poker (for example, seven-card stud), some of each player's cards are laid (face-up) on the table so that the other players can see them. In community card poker (for example, Texas hold 'em), players share some of their cards in the center of the table.[1]

The history of poker is a matter of some debate. The name of the game likely descended from the French poque, which descended from the German pochen ('to knock'), but it is not clear whether the origins of poker itself lie with the games bearing those names. It closely resembles the Persian game of as nas, and may have been taught to French settlers in New Orleans by Persian sailors. It is commonly regarded as sharing ancestry with the Renaissance game of primero and the French brelan. The English game brag (earlier bragg) clearly descended from brelan and incorporated bluffing (though the concept was known in other games by that time). It is quite possible that all of these earlier games influenced the development of poker as it exists now.

English actor Joseph

Crowell reported that the game was played in New Orleans in 1829, with a deck of 20 cards, four players betting on which player's hand was the most valuable. Jonathan H. Green's book, An Exposure of the Arts and Miseries of Gambling (G. B. Zieber, Philadelphia, 1843), described the spread of the game from there to the rest of the country by Mississippi riverboats, on which gambling was a common pastime.

Soon after

this spread, the full 52-card English deck was used, and the flush was introduced. During the American Civil War, many additions were made, including draw poker, stud poker (the five-card variant), and the straight. Further American developments followed, such as the wild card (around 1875), lowball and split-pot poker (around 1900), and community card poker games (around 1925). Spread of the game to other countries, particularly in Asia, is often attributed to the U.S. military.

The game and

jargon of poker have become important parts of American culture and English culture. Such phrases as ace in the hole, beats me, blue chip, call the bluff, cash in, pass the buck, poker face, stack up, up the ante, when the chips are down, wild card, and others are used in everyday conversation even by those unaware of their origins at the poker table.

Modern tournament play became popular in American casinos after the World Series of Poker began in 1970. It was also during that decade that the first serious strategy books appeared, notably *The Theory of Poker* by David Sklansky (ISBN 1880685000), *Super System* by Doyle Brunson (ISBN 1580420818), and *The Book of Tells* by Mike Caro (ISBN 0897461002).

Poker became more popular early in the 21st century, largely due to the introduction of online poker and the invention of the hole-card camera which finally turned the game into a spectator sport. Viewers could now follow the action and drama of the game, and broadcasts of poker tournaments such as the World Series of Poker and the World Poker Tour brought in large television audiences.

The game of poker is played in hundreds of variations, but the following overview of game play applies to most of them.

Depending on the game

rules, one or more players may be required to place an initial amount of money into the pot before the cards are dealt. These are called forced bets and come in three forms: antes, blinds, and bring-ins.

Like most card games, the dealer shuffles the deck of cards. The deck is then cut, and the appropriate number of cards are dealt face-down to the players. In a casino a "house" dealer handles the cards for each hand, but a button (any small item used as a marker, also called a buck) is rotated among the players to determine the order of dealing and betting in certain games. In a home game, the right to deal the cards typically rotates among the players clockwise, but a button may still be used.

After the initial deal, the first of what may be several betting rounds begins. Between rounds, the players' hands develop in some way, often by being dealt additional cards or replacing cards previously dealt. During a round of betting, there will always be a current bet amount, which is the total amount of money bet in this round by the player who bet last in this round. To keep better track of this, it is conventional for players to not place their bets directly into the pot (called splashing the pot), but rather place them in front of themselves toward the pot, until the betting round is over. When the round is over, the bets are then gathered into the pot.

After the first betting round is completed (every participating player having called an equal amount), there may be more rounds in which more cards are dealt in various ways, followed by further rounds of betting (into the same central pot). At any time during the first or subsequent betting rounds, if one player makes a bet and all other players fold, the deal ends immediately, the single remaining player is awarded the pot, no cards are shown, no more rounds are dealt, and the next deal begins. This

is what makes it possible to bluff.

At the end of the last betting round, if more than one player remains, there is a showdown in which the players reveal their previously hidden cards and evaluate their hands. The player with the best hand according to the poker variant being played wins the pot.

The following are poker hands, from best to worst:

Straight flush : Five cards of the same suit in sequence (if those five are A, K, Q, J, 10; it is a Royal Flush)

: Five cards of the same suit in sequence (if those five are A, K, Q, J, 10; it is a) Four of a kind : Four cards of the same rank and any one other card

: Four cards of the same rank and any one other card Full house : Three cards of one rank and two of another

: Three cards of one rank and two of another Flush

: Five cards of the same suit

Poker chips are small discs. They made by various materials including molded plastic, colored metal molded clays. They are used in table games as play money. Modern poker traces its roots towards the 1800s, and in those days, players used what you could to help keep a tally. Coins, gold dust and nuggets were used until they considered replacing with something which would indicate them. Thus, the casino chips happen to be introduced within the gambling business.

Poker rooms started using casino chips to

simply manage the cash and then collect charges. In those days, casino chips were created of ivory, bone, paper wood. However, the most generally used chips were created of composite clay. One problem made an appearance due to the developing casino chips which was cheating. Some players considered sneaking some chips in their hands. To avoid this, manufacturers created differentiated disks. Consequently, a range of styles was created. With time, other manufacturers could use many other materials for making casino chips, for example, plastic and metal.[2]

Magnus Carlsen se enfrentará a Hans Niemann en el Campeonato de Velocidad de Chess.com

Magnus Carlsen, ex campeón mundial pero aún clasificado como el número 1 del mundo, se enfrentará al controvertido talento en ascenso Hans Niemann, de 21 años, en el tablero el próximo mes por primera vez desde el Torneo Sinquefield de 2024, cuando su partido de tercera ronda, ganado por Niemann, desató acusaciones de trampa y una demanda por R\$100 millones. La opinión actual es que el incidente no involucró trampa, y mucho menos bolas anales.

Niemann ganó nuevamente esta semana en su gira europea cuando derrotó al tercer francés Étienne Bacrot, 4.5-1.5 en la sección clásica de su partido en París. Ha alcanzado el puesto 19 en las calificaciones en vivo, su más alto hasta ahora, siguiendo victorias anteriores contra el holandés número 1, Anish Giri, en Utrecht y el inglés número 1, el ex ruso Nikita Vitiugov, en Londres. Ambos fueron por márgenes convincentes.

La rápida jugada y el estilo táctico de Niemann produjeron una victoria llamativa en el juego cuatro, aunque Bacrot omitió el salvamento oculto de Stockfish 24...Rxf7! 25 Rxf7 Qxh2+ 26 Kf2 d4! El maniobra 16 a4-a5! de Niemann con 19 Ra4-f4! que crea una pistola de Alekhine en la columna f se ve original.

Carlsen, quien se enfrenta a Niemann el 6 de septiembre en París en su primera reunión desde el juego tristemente célebre del Torneo Sinquefield, ganó otro Titled Tuesday en línea esta semana, para el que se preparó con una partida de nueve juegos 3+0 el lunes contra Ediz Gurel, de 15 años, de Turquía, quien es uno de los más jóvenes grandes maestros del mundo.

Carlsen ganó 8-1, perdiendo el juego ocho, pero a pesar de la puntuación unilateral, Gurel desempeñó su parte en una buena partida. Todos los nueve juegos están en YouTube.

El partido Carlsen v Niemann será una semifinal del Campeonato de Velocidad de Chess.com, cuyas rondas anteriores se jugaron en línea, pero cuyas últimas etapas serán en el tablero. La otra semifinal es Hikaru Nakamura v Alireza Firouzja.

Rondas anteriores del campeonato de velocidad se jugaron exclusivamente en línea, pero París será un evento híbrido, donde los oponentes se sentarán uno frente al otro, pero jugarán en computadoras separadas. Habrá 90 minutos de 5+1 ajedrez relámpago, 60 minutos de 3+1 ajedrez relámpago y 30 minutos de 1+1 ajedrez a toda velocidad. Carlsen dijo que preferiría un oponente diferente, pero "si tengo un buen día, probablemente ganaré sin demasiados problemas".

El noruego es el campeón mundial reinante de ajedrez relámpago, un título que ha ganado en seis ocasiones anteriores. Niemann también es un jugador fuerte de ajedrez relámpago, clasificado como No 5 en ajedrez relámpago por Chess.com, pero debería ser una partida unilateral a menos de que Carlsen se distraiga emocionalmente por la charla basura previa al juego u otros factores externos.

Mientras tanto, el Torneo Sinquefield de 2024 ha llegado a la cuarta ronda (de nueve) con una alta proporción de empates, como ha sido su tradición durante varios años. El campeón mundial de China, Ding Liren, ha continuado su forma mejorada mostrada en el Campeonato Mundial de Equipos Rápido/Relámpago. Ding sacrificó un caballo y torre por jaque perpetuo contra Gukesh en la ronda uno, aunque podría haber intentado más por 20 Rg3! En la ronda dos, Giri sacrificó su reina contra Ding, también por jaque perpetuo; mientras que en las rondas tres y cuatro, Ding tuvo ventajas casi ganadoras contra So y Fabiano Caruana, pero las desperdició ambas.

Bodhana Sivanandan, la número 1 del mundo preadolescente, obtuvo otro resultado impresionante la semana pasada en las calificaciones para el Campeonato de Velocidad de Mujeres de Chess.com (3+1 velocidad). La alumna de la escuela primaria de Harrow, de nueve años, cuya calificación de velocidad de Chess.com ya está por encima de 2500, participó en todos los cuatro eventos de 48 jugadores, se enfrentó a muchos oponentes titulados y anotó 6.5, 7, 7 y 7.5 de 11. En su tercer torneo, derrotó a la holandesa WIM, Eline Roebers, de excelente manera, mientras que en su cuarto estuvo cerca de calificar para las semifinales.

La semana pasada, el Invitational de Kingston, organizado por el Guardian's Stephen Moss, ganó un nicho en la historia del ajedrez cuando produjo el juego decisivo más largo jamás jugado, 272 movimientos. Billy Fellowes v FM Peter Lalic provocó controversia cuando surgió que Lalic ha estado buscando este récord durante unos años y ya tiene varios juegos de tres dígitos registrados en bases de datos.

Fellowes continuó hasta el amargo final, como es su costumbre. El niño de 12 años es uno de varios jóvenes que rara vez se rinden y juegan hasta el jaque mate. El juego se aplazó por la noche porque el encargado quería cerrar la Escuela Tiffin Boys y se reanudó a las 8.30 am para no retrasar la siguiente ronda.

Algunos críticos querían una doble descalificación por desacreditar el juego, pero eso abre una lata de gusanos. No hay verificación oficial de récords de ajedrez, el juego se calificará normalmente por la Fide y esperaría que Wikipedia actualice su entrada de un juego de 1979 que duró solo 269 movimientos con torre y alfil contra torre. Hay dos juegos más largos en Chessbase, pero son empates que continuaron durante cientos de movimientos en posiciones

totalmente bloqueadas.

El resultado más notable en Kingston fue de Stanley Badacsonyi, quien empató en el primer lugar con 6.5/9, ganó más de 100 puntos de calificación y calificó para el título de FM: un logro triple para el adolescente de 14 años de Muswell Hill. Badacsonyi todavía está detrás de sus contemporáneos, Shreyas Royal y Sohum Lohia, pero su estilo de ataque energético promete más éxitos en el futuro. Kingston está en un buen lugar en el calendario de ajedrez, aunque necesita más jugadores titulados para apoyar las normas de GM e IM.
